

Inscription of Moidams – the Mound-Burial system of the Ahom Dynasty as 43rd World Heritage Property of India

On 26th July 2024, Moidams — the Mound-Burial system of the Ahom Dynasty, Charaideo, Assam is inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. It is the 43rd World Heritage Property of India and the 3rd World Heritage Property of Assam and the 1st World Heritage Property in Cultural Category in Northeast India.
